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[00:00:16] You know, some of them, you know, having had sex that much. So you can do whatever you want, any act, but just, I remember be, just be delicate. She's like, what in the world's wrong with you, bro?

[00:00:37] Hey guys. Tim Ballard here. This is in the trenches. These are the stories of Operation Underground Railroad, our successes, our challenges, our operations, and if you want to donate to make sure that we can continue to make these stories by doing real rescue operations, please go to ourrescue.org and help us out. Thanks so much.

[00:01:01] Hey guys. Welcome to another episode of In The Trenches. I'm here with my trustee, co-host, Matthew Cooper. So bad guys. Pedophiles, what? What? What's your impression? You've seen a lot of bad guys over the years. We've done so many operations together. We see these people. Who are they? What do they look like? People want to believe that they're like greasy, creepy.

[00:01:22] **Matt:** Like not always. Sometimes they're disappointing in their presentation. They look, they're like punks, wimps. Sometimes, or sometimes they're females, women. Beautiful women even.

[00:01:34] **Tim:** Yeah. Yeah. There's no profile. And that's the thing. I think that's alarming to people and that's why I think child exploitation and human trafficking are so prevalent because you cannot. You cannot kind of profile someone, you can't identify easily who they could be. They look like normal people often. Like you said, people are really shocked when they find out that any human trafficking network that's has any success has a really talented, that's, I hate using that word cuz it's just evil, right, but a talented female who takes care of the victims. Why is that?

[00:02:09] **Matt:** If I had to, you know, use my experience as an educated guess, these women had worked in the sex industry themselves. They understand it. They're taking that skill that they use for themselves. However they got into it, I have no idea, but they then turn it on victims of trafficking.

[00:02:28] **Tim:** Yeah, they are good also because for their bad business, because kids trust them. Kids trust females quicker.

[00:02:36] **Matt:** I think that's probably the most important part

[00:02:38] **Tim:** and that's what's so frightening too. I mean, we've been working a trafficker for a couple years, female in Mexico, finally, just a few weeks ago, finally was arrested. We just interrogated her. Last week you and I were down in Mexico, right? And she's agreed to help us cuz she wants a reduced sentence or whatever to help find the kids. But she was telling us that she was selling children as young as six years old. In fact, at one point, you remember she had a party set up.

[00:03:06] And it was like a product testing party. She wanted us to see all the kids that she had and she's bringing them to this party and she told us and the, you know, there was a warrant for her arrest that was issued an hour or two before the party. We asked the Mexicans to not do that way because she was so connected and she provides certain services to even politicians, you know, that we don't know who they're exactly.

[00:03:28] Sure enough, within 30 minutes probably of them issuing the warrant. The day of the operation, she calls us and says, run. I don't know if you're on my side or what, but we're being betrayed by the government. Like, oh my gosh. And so that's why it's so frustrating. But this woman was bragging to us about how at these parties or if someone buys a child, they'll have a doctor.

[00:03:54] Who will be there on site to, to literally, and I'm sorry, this is raw and horrifying, but you need to know this is the world of human trafficking and child sex slavery. But this doctor would basically like sew up, stitch up the kids after they're brutally, you know, torn apart. Oh. They'll be back in service six to eight weeks and she's talking to us like, we're gonna like this cuz we're going into business with like, we can get 'em back making money again. Right.

[00:04:23] This is another reason why we use female operators, like female operators at our foundation are some of the most effective tools we have. Because when there's a female trafficker, And they see that another woman is also betraying everything about who they are as a person, as a mother, as a woman, it's almost like misery love's company.

[00:04:44] They'll start talking more to that female. Now remember the undercover operator, Lisa, with this particular woman, she loved her. Yeah. Because it's like, oh, another woman's cool with this. And so she starts revealing a lot of things that she otherwise would not. So we love our female undercover operators for that reason.

[00:05:00] Remember in the one, one of the very first cases we did, We were helping out a county in the United States. They asked us to come and consult on how to infiltrate into social media networks and platforms to find if anyone in their little town of like 30,000 if kids might be getting abused. You were with me.

[00:05:20] Right?

[00:05:20] **Matt:** Some of that not all their trips, but some of it

[00:05:23] **Tim:** we ended up digging so deep. In fact, one of our, the guy who runs our Central America office was the chief investigator in that county, and now he runs OUR's Central America office. After we set it up for them, they said, well, you do the undercover work too.

[00:05:39] Show us how to do this. How do you talk to these guys when they show up? So they had to actually hire me because like, well, Just cuz this is, the United States doesn't make it, you know? Right. I'm not a sworn officer anymore. So they literally hired me for like a dollar a year. So I was part of the county DA's office and so I got to do the undercover work.

[00:05:57] And you might remember the story this guy shows up to this farmhouse in the middle of nowhere cuz he thinks, he believes cuz the honey pot that the DA's office had set was, there's children as young as nine, I believe. And you could come and have sex with his kid. Right. The guy, he's a choir director at like an elementary school or a church.

[00:06:17] He shows up and I'm, you know, I'm in role and I've got, we had terror with us, so we had good disguises and stuff. And he rolls in, he is like, come over here. He and I stand up and walk. I'm kind of pretending to be a little drunk or whatever. I'm like, what's up? The kid's upstairs, you know, and I come, you know, within like three or four feet of him and he stops and he goes, he looks at me like, he's like, we're gonna have like a dual or something. I'm just like, what's he doing? And then he like goes,

[00:06:43] I'm like, what are you doing, bro? He's like, ah. I'm like, what? That's weird. What are you doing? And he's like, oh, well, can you come a little closer? I'm like, I come a little closer. And he just whoop. He just comes up and just grabs my privates, gives 'em a good squeeze, and I'm just looking, I don't do anything.

[00:07:04] I just look at 'em like cash, like. Dude, what the hell? Where the hell? Who the hell are you doing, bro? He's like, ah. And he runs in his car and drives away. What is going on? Like we had all the chats for this guy, right? Yeah. And they're like, dude, this guy, he's wants to have sex with his 10 year old kid.

[00:07:22] And 15 minutes later we see the headlights coming back. He's coming back like, what is up? Okay, stay places everybody right? He comes, I meet him outside. I'm just like, bro. You got a picture of me. I've got like this mustache. I'm like this. I'm like, bro, what are you doing? What's up? Do you want the kid or not?

[00:07:40] He's like, before I have sex with a kid, just do me one more, do me a favor. I'm like, yeah. He's like, "will you pull your pants down so I can see your dick?" I'm just quoting like, He's not doing what he said. I'm bro. I'm like, bro, you've grabbed it. You know it's there. Okay. You're doing some weird thing with your hands.

[00:07:58] I don't know who, I'm like, you can come or not, but I'm not gonna pull my pants down. He's like, oh, okay, fine. I'll come have sex with the kid. So then, boom, he gets arrested that night. Well, later they did a search warrant at his house and they called me like, dude he was like looking at websites, how to identify an undercover operator.

[00:08:18] Like, pretend you're gonna go for a gun. And they'll they won't be able to resist and they'll go for their gun. Well, I don't carry a gun when I do undercover work for me, I, it's more dangerous to have a gun than not. Grab their genitalia because cops hate that and they're gonna be like, ah, you, I'm a cop. Don't touch me.

[00:08:36] Like, luckily I just stayed in role. I was just like, What's up, bro? You know? And then the last one, like they, they're not allowed to show you their private parts of you, so something. Anyway. Crazy bizarre people, right? Yeah. The risks that they're willing to take to engage. I mean, he knows. He knows very well we could be cops obviously.

[00:08:57] **Matt:** Right, but the, yeah, he's proven that.

[00:08:59] **Tim:** But the risk, he was able, he was willing to take, to have sex with a kid and that's what's scary, right? The lengths people will go to, to engage in this behavior. It's very frightening. Who else comes to mind as a bad guy worth talking about?

[00:09:15] **Matt:** Eduardo. I know you, you visited with him recently in Columbia and he's kind of like the opposite of like, you know, you would think it'd be someone with like face tattoos and gang relations, but it's just kind of this sad beta male. Picks on kids. I think he has kids of his own, doesn't he?

[00:09:30] **Tim:** Yeah. Yeah, that, so this is the guy in Triple Take, and I just testified in his trial about a month or so ago. I think he had about eight kids that he sold for sex. But we, this was the whole thing, and this is all depicted in the Sound of Freedom, the movie Sound of Freedom, which will be coming out on Angel Studios later this year, either summer or fall, I think. But we wanted to rescue all the kids. In this, in Cartagena, in this region of Columbia.

[00:09:55] We got into a conversation with him about what's his long-term plans and we ended up deciding that we were gonna build a sex hotel together. And he already had the property for it. He already wanted to do it, so we kind of just walked into it and like said, well, we can facilitate. What do you need? He's like, I need investment.

[00:10:09] You bring the money, I'll bring the kids and we'll be you'll, you can bring your pedophile clients down here forever. Right. And I remember they had 12 year old girls in the room, like, oh, she's a thousand dollars and he's normal as anything. I mean, he could be the bartender, he could be the waiter, he could be your buddy.

[00:10:26] You know, he wore nice clothes. Yeah, preppy clothes, you know, had a decent like condo and Columbia, and here he is selling 12 year olds and you have a video, you review the video for the trial and just like, Hey, be gentle with these girls. You know, some of them, you know, haven't had sex that much, so you can do whatever you want in any act, but just I remember be just be delicate.

[00:10:49] I'm just like, what in the world's wrong with you, bro? Sometimes traffickers often they will kind of distance themselves from the crime and they'll talk about it more like it's a commodity or like selling computers or something. Like, they don't get personal, they like go with her, you know, like, be delicate.

[00:11:06] Like I knew those words would come back and haunt him. And then he pulls his phone up at one point and he shows a picture of Of a little girl and I'm like, oh, he is gonna send me another girl. And, but no, this one is, he's in the picture I noticed. I'm like, oh. And he's like, well, that's my daughter.

[00:11:25] She's she beautiful. I'm like, bro, you just spent the last two hours showing me pictures of girls close to her age, who you want my clients to rape so you can have money in your pocket, and then you just go and here's my daughter. And she's sweet, and she, I'm like, well, the other kids are someone's daughter. You know?

[00:11:47] **Matt:** Yeah.

[00:11:47] **Tim:** Like the ability, these guys have to compartmentalize.

[00:11:50] **Matt:** Yeah. Disassociated. Their brains are broken. I mean, I can't understand it. I don't even want to. Just rather help put 'em away.

[00:11:56] **Tim:** So let me ask you that as an undercover operator, I think we're broken brains too.

[00:12:02] **Matt:** Yeah. Yeah. I'd say so.

[00:12:04] **Tim:** Because to, to be in that world and then come out of it and then go back in it, and then go out of it like,

[00:12:09] **Matt:** yeah, it does suck.

[00:12:10] **Tim:** Yeah, it does.

[00:12:11] **Matt:** It's like a punch in the gut sometimes when I come home.

[00:12:13] **Tim:** It messes with you.

[00:12:14] **Matt:** Yeah.

[00:12:14] **Tim:** I had this neighbor once come up to me and she meant well, but it was so offensive. Her line of questioning, she was like, eventually you're going undercover. And eventually, I'm sure you get desensitized and you start getting attracted to the kids too. It becomes normal and I was just like, my blood boiled and it's like really? The 100th time you see a video of a child screaming in pain while she's being raped?

[00:12:42] Yeah. Eventually it's that actually I said it's the opposite. Ble bleep. It, the hole just gets bigger and bigger in your brain. It doesn't get easier, like the

fact that you're still here and that you're, there's still new videos being produced. You do not get me sensitized to that stuff.

[00:12:57] **Matt:** No, I think that question kind of assumes like, you w you want that, you just don't allow yourself to until, you know, that's kinda what pedophiles say. Everybody's interested in this.

[00:13:06] **Tim:** Yeah. It's the puritanical society that stops us. In fact, there's a character in the film Sound of Freedom that I arrested. He was a brilliant mind, sick twisted, but brilliant mind and very high IQ, wrote books. He had a postmortem declaration, I have it somewhere that he put on all his albums of child exploitation material. And it just talked about how children are beautiful and once hair starts growing, once, like pubic hair starts growing, then it become ugly.

[00:13:37] Like that's their prime. And of course it's beautiful. And then they get into like, you know, Alfred Kinzie, the sick twisted freak who is a sexologist, right? Right. He's the modern, he's the father of our sex education system insanely. But also he's the father of pedophilia because he did all this research where he literally like condoned or even encouraged, the rape of children so he could see when they have orgasms, if they have orgasms.

[00:14:05] **Matt:** Disgusting.

[00:14:06] **Tim:** And he tried to, what he was doing was trying to normalize it. He was trying to normalize this kind of sexual deviant behavior with children or whatever else. And he said, look, the sampling shows that 80% of people want have sex with kids.

[00:14:18] Well, the sampling he went to was a to a prison of convicted rapists and other criminals. And that's who he took the sampling from it. And he said, it doesn't matter. I took it from the prison. I can take it from the grocery store. No, it does matter cuz you, but he didn't tell you that. He just said, here's this look.

[00:14:36] In other words, if 80% of people want this, it shouldn't be illegal. That was his point. So pedophilia should be legalized. Sex with children should be legalized. So the pedophiles today, that's what they say and that's what they use.

[00:14:48] **Matt:** I was just remembering our friend Kara Top in Mexico City,

[00:14:51] **Tim:** Mattman.

[00:14:52] **Matt:** Yeah. That's a freak.

[00:14:53] **Tim:** Yeah, that's a freak. He's like an Alfred Kinsey follower in, he's part of a political party. Arrested in 2020 in Holland. While waiting at trial, they let him keep his passport. He fled. Fugitive. Find him in Mexico two years later. In association with work we're doing in Ukraine, and here we are, we extract him from his rat hole and he gets arrested.

[00:15:15] But part of what Mattman, his group and others like these, well, what's happening is these pedophiles are kind of organizing now. It used to be a very much a closet crime. You know, they would hide it, you know, they just, as long as they got the kids. Not anymore. Like they're starting to like be encouraged and bolstered by our culture, which in their quest to be tolerant, are trying to be tolerant to children being raped. I'm not. I'm not. It's insanity. I can't believe that we have got to this place. A complete disregard for children, you know? And they call evil good and good evil, and they're buying into this like, well, what kid hasn't been molested?

[00:15:57] Or the kid might like it. It might feel good for them too. It might be good for their brains. Like we, we know the research on what sexualizing kids does to their brain. Destroys them, and they're in therapy and messed up their whole lives. Like we know what happens. So there's this movement, right.

[00:16:15] And part of the movement tries to discredit the whole human trafficking thing. You know, like the Atlantic did this piece that we featured, featured estimate about the great fake child sex epidemic. Like it was insane. Insane. This is the kind of thinking that they do at The Atlantic, right? She basically said, well, based the amount of calls to the national hotline human trafficking hotline, there was only like 19,000 calls last year, so how could there be 2 million children in sex trafficking?

[00:16:42] Like there you go. That's like saying that we go fishing out in the ocean and let's say we spent two days out there fishing, and I'm like, huh? People say there's hundred of thousands, even millions of fish out here. We only cut 30. Huh? There's no, ugh. I mean, that's what they're, it's insanity. Like these are journalists. No, it's not journalism. It's agenda pushing. It's sick. And one of the things they're peddling is stop calling them pedophiles. Pedophile has a negative connotation. Damn right. It does. That's a red flag. Well, let's get rid of the red flag. Why? That's the indicator. You call someone a pedophile, you wake up and you protect your kids. No, let's call them minor attracted persons.

[00:17:22] **Matt:** Right? And Mattman, he's trying to be a leader of that movement. Yeah. Which has made him interesting. Yeah. It felt good to take 'em down. Yeah, I did.

[00:17:29] **Tim:** Yeah, I did. Do you wanna change the name pedophiles and minor attracted persons?

[00:17:33] **Matt:** Hell no

[00:17:34] **Tim:** why. You freaking intolerant bigot.

[00:17:38] **Matt:** Because I don't tolerate it. I mean, I don't understand it. I don't even wanna understand it. I don't want to think about it because if I think about it, I mean, it's just repulsive to even think too hard about it. Rather just them go to jail.

[00:17:49] **Tim:** But look what they're doing, the same groups, they're pushing maps, they're also pushing the sex relation of our kids. Look at the stuff they're telling 'em under sex education. It's pornography they're showing them, third graders. Teaching them to masturbate how to do it. All these things are going towards what? Grooming children, right? So the pedophiles are back going, we've been promoting this stuff for decades and we have like close to half the country buying into it now. Now, I'm not saying that they're not making, they're too dumb to make the connection, like, Hey, guess what? Your policies are making salivate. Maybe you should slow down and think about what you're doing and before you fill your, all our kids' heads with sexual material and get them addicted to sex through touching themselves and then priming them.

[00:18:35] So what, so the pedophile can swoop in and, you know, and now kids can consent. Biden is talking about kids actually have the right to consent to cutting their genitalia off because they, they claim they're in the wrong body. I've talked to therapists, I think at 22 states. You can't even try to say maybe there's another problem.

[00:18:52] Oh. How evil, you'll lose your license. All you can do is gender affirm. It's like, wait a minute. That's like having an anorexic 10 year old come in and let's say she weighs 50 pounds and you're freaking out, and she comes and sits and she's like, I feel fat. I identify as being in a fat body and that's what anorexic people do.

[00:19:11] Right? Right. So that'd be like saying, oh well let's get you some liposuction and put you on a diet. It's insanity. And then she would die. There's

no difference. Right. You can't even consider anything else. So why is that also scary? Cuz the pedophile are loving this movement too. This trans voice. I don't care about adult adults can do what they want.

[00:19:29] It's none of my business, not the governor's business. But kids. No, you can't. You can't do this. You're basically forcing them into some crazy idea that someone on the internet told 'em that will make their lives better. Right?

[00:19:40] **Matt:** Yeah. I don't get it.

[00:19:41] **Tim:** But why do pedophiles love this? Well, if kids can consent to that, then they can consent to sex. How can you say they can't? Or, you know, gender fluidity. Right. And parents get awards for affirming that concept of gender fluidity and minors. What about age fluidity? Like what? What's more fluid? Age or gender? I mean, age is more fluid.

[00:20:08] **Matt:** I don't know what's not fluid. I mean,

[00:20:10] **Tim:** but age. I mean, you know when we rescued Colay and Colleen and then we adopted them, we knew they were a boy and a girl. We knew that. We didn't know their age. There was no paper, there was no birth certificate. So that's why I'm making that's the point. That's fluid. We had to guess on an age. So what happens when mom and dad are throwing out all the science and reason and you know, therapists can't even do their jobs anymore because the mainstream therapy being run by activists, not by medical service providers right.

[00:20:42] And mom and dad are getting awards for gender affirming. Well, what happens when the 12 year old says, I'm also 40. No, you're not sweetie cuz if you're 40, that means you can have sex with that 45 year old man who wants to have sex with you. Yeah. I don't want to, my sexualized brain that you put me through over the last, you know, the first 12 years of my life has turned me into kind of a sexual being and I kind of wanna have sex.

[00:21:03] And this 40 year old's pretty hot, but I'm 12, but I'm 40. No, sweetie, you can't be that. What do you, no, you, it's too late. You've lost reason. You've lost the fight. Every defense mechanism you could deploy at that point to help your kids see, you've already thrown out the window when you said that. She's in the wrong body. How can you say that's not fluid? The age is not. Age is fluid too.

[00:21:22] **Matt:** It's scary where it goes.

[00:21:23] **Tim:** It's super scary where we're heading. The scariest part for me is all these policies that are being pushed by the woke around children are the exact policies the pedophiles like Mattman and the North American Man boy Love Association and Alfred Kinsey.

[00:21:38] It's what they've been pushing for half a century. And they're sitting back and going, they're doing it for us. They're doing it for us. And they're not associating themselves with pedophiles, of course, but they don't, pedophiles don't care. As long as the result is what it is. And that's what, and that's where we're heading.

[00:21:53] So wake up, everybody. Wake up, mom and dad, grandma, grandpa. Don't be tricked by this, what I call the child trap. It's also a parent trap cuz parents are getting tricked into it. And it's gonna close on you. If you don't wake up and when it closes, it's gonna be too late. So with that, we will sign off and see you next time on In the Trenches.
